Plan outfits IN ADVANCE

Choose clothing in colours which compliment the muted shades of Autumn. Hues of orange, mustard yellow paired with denim or navy work beautifully. Avoid matchy matchy siblings outfits and include closed footwear.

If you're unsure, send me a phone shot of your outfits a week or so before your session and I'll take a look. I also have a few outfits which can be borrowed if needed.

It's all about **THE LAYERS**

This time of year can be sunny one moment and chilly the next. Think vests or t-shirts layered under shirts or dresses in turn layered under jackets, cardigans or jumpers. Fun socks look amazing peeking over the top of boots too!

Add variety to your images by mixing things up by removing or adding layers midway through your session.

CHECK DIRECTIONS

30 MINUTE SESSION

KEEP IN TOUCH
